PCSO Galley reported on the increase in shoplifting activity at Tesco Stores. Members agreed to write to the store and ask for their commitment to remain security aware and extra vigilant to address this increase in activity.

Parishioners asked that the police address issues raised regarding the numerous reports of inconsiderate parking at the junction of Aldi car park /Lloyds Chemist/ Domino Pizza.

A parishioner asked for police to liaise with Licensee of The Anchor to look at the hazardous parking of delivery vehicles on the corner of High Street/Mill Green Way making it difficult accessibility for pedestrians & motorists.
