**COUNTY COUNCIL**

The Chairman welcomed Cllr Western to the meeting.

Cllr Western explained that she was addressing the Council budget for the future and looking to protect essential services. She would give a detailed report in 2015.

A Member asked that DCC address the problems facing pedestrians crossing the high way at the junction of Creswell Road/Hickinwood Lane/Station Road, Clowne following the recent accident. Cllr Western would report back to the Highways Dept; to investigate possibilities for the future. She added that there were several highway factors and issues that needed to be addressed.

Reports of dangerous parking on Hickinwood Lane (limited pedestrian access) gave cause for concern. Cllr Western would recommend Highways Dept., look at the area.

## **MINUTES – 3/11/14**

145/14 Resolved that the Minutes of the Clowne Parish Council meeting held on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2014 be approved and adopted and are signed as a true record.

### **UPDATE & PRESENTATION BY ANDREW TEBBS, ARTIST (commissioned for works to Garden of Remembrance – Clowne Parish War Memorial 2014/15)**

The Chairman welcomed Andrew Tebbs to the meeting.

Andrew Tebbs gave the following report: New Centenary artwork proposal 1914-2014. On the site adjacent to and north of the existing war memorial on land donated by ALDI store, it is proposed to create an extension to the memorial which will provide a quiet contemplative space with seating and themed artworks.

The paved area will have inlaid within it a large red stone carved poppy in Red Cumbrian sandstone, symbolic of the First World War and marking the centenary since its start in 1914. Secondly forming an enclosing arc around the poppy will be seating and four free standing walls with a stone relief carved of images of people on the home front that made sacrifices during wartime.

The Land Army, and the effort to provide enough food for everyone

The Bevan Boys and regular miners digging coal for the power to keep industry going

The Munitions workers and others such as steel workers and textile workers who kept the forces supplied with equipment

The doctors & nurses who cared for all the casualties of war.

This has been presented through the weeks/ months of consultation with parishioners.

Poppy Artwork: The piece to be carved in St Bee's Red sandstone (dark red) and Coreshill sandstone (light red). The translucent overlapping petals will be made visible by using a darker shade of red sandstone.

Carved Panels These curve around the poppy and face the War Memorial in an arc of simple stone seats and sections of freestanding wall to which will be embedded stone carved relief style panels. Each panel will depict the contributions and sacrifice made by many local people that worked on the home front. The stone artwork will be made of materials that are durable and frost resistant. They will have a long life and minimal maintenance.

Lighting It is proposed to light the paving around the poppy carving with exterior quality architectural LED lighting.

Andrew explained that he felt that the proposed design of the project was symbolic rather than representation he added that he hoped for a start on the project in early 2015.

The Chairman thanked Andrew Tebbs for a very informative and detailed presentation on the proposed extension to the Clowne War Memorial area.

Members welcomed the proposals.

### **ACTION FROM THE PUBLIC FORUM**

146/14 The Chairman reported on the various items of business relating to the BDC, DCC and police which had been discussed and would be forwarded on to the relevant Departments.

147/14 Following the discussion in the Parish Forum, it was resolved that Bolsover District Council,, Derbyshire County Council and Clowne Parish Council would look into the development of a Neighbourhood Plan for Clowne. The Chairman accepted the need

to actively seek financial commitment from available sources. Further discussion to take place in January 2015.

### **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT**

148/14 The Chairman reported on the recent Annual Firework Event and festive lighting 'switch on' held on Villa Park & The Centre on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2014. The weather was mild with no adverse weather conditions and the firework display (by Fuse Firework Co.) was excellent. The event was a successful community event – well attended with many families turning out for an evening of entertainment provided by funfair, games, face painting, disco etc. Resolved all associated costs to be approved for payment.

The Chairman extended his thanks and appreciation to all Parish Council and Centre staff for their continued hardwork.

149/14 The Chairman reported on the forthcoming festive events and activities to be held at The Centre in December:

It was resolved that associated costs for the festive events be approved for payment.

150/14 The Chairman gave a brief report on the restrictions and update on legislation for the installation of the Parish festive lighting. The Parish Council had contracted P & D Specialist Services (HERS qualified) as recommend by DCC to install 2014/15 illuminations. Resolved to approve associated costs.

154/14 The Chairman gave a brief report on a recent meeting with Clowne in Bloom re: Micro grant application towards the planting of area on Mill Green Way, Clowne. Cllr Reid explained that the Parish Council had acquired a Cultivation License and would look to enhance the area with wildflower, formal shrubs & plants and a Mediterranean area (3 x raised beds) enclosed with sleepers. The Parish Council & Clowne In Bloom would work in partnership to develop an area of low maintenance and a visual impact display at a roadside area. Date of next meeting: 16/02/2015.

155/14 A request had been received from BCN Consultancy NEDDC re: suggestion for street naming of development off Rotherham Road, Clowne. The proposed names were not acceptable. Resolved that street naming of this area be in keeping with 'sailcloth'

which was historically produced at this location. Resolved that Chairman authorize street names following investigation of appropriate names of sails (suggestions: *Spinnaker, Lateen, Mizzen, Gennaker, Sprintsail*)
