14/14 Resolved that the Minutes of the Clowne Parish Council meeting held on Monday 2nd June be approved and adopted and are signed as a true record.

ACTION FROM THE PUBLIC FORUM

15/14 The Chairman reported on the various items of business relating to BDC, DCC and the police which had been discussed and would be forwarded to the relevant Departments.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Chairman gave a detailed report on the forthcoming Party on the Park to be held on Saturday 12th July on the Villa Park area.

- 11 local bands playing throughout the day 12noon > 10pm (associated costs agreed)
- 20 local football teams (7 a side) playing a mini world cup tournament with final @ 3pm (associated costs agreed)
- Funfair, Face painting and stalls (contributions to Help for Heroes)
- Marquee Licensed Bar 12noon > 10pm

The event is a community event with local clubs & businesses participating.

16/14 Members resolved to accept the associated costs and looked forward to successful event.

17/14 Cllr Reid reported that successful funding applications had been received towards the proposed Garden of Remembrance; £17,500 Section 106 Ben Bailey, £5,400 DET LaFarage (correspondence 6.q) & Aldi (land dedication). Various other sources of funding will continue to be applied for to meet the required cost.

Cllr Reid explained that the consultation process and pre-development works will continue with various local community groups in the lead up to the commencement of works after 11th November 2014.

20/14 A request had been received from Clowne & Barlborough Walking Group for financial assistance. It was resolved that Clowne Parish Council agree to waiver annual (2015) affiliation fee for The Centre and give a FOC letting for use of the main hall to hold a fund raising event.

required to extend their garden and subsequent cultivate the land. Members agreed that this request not be granted as the land is required by a wayleave agreement to enable BT access above/over for maintenance of cables. It was resolved that the area was to be cleared of overgrown weeds and problem vegetation cut back.

It was resolved that the Parish Council facilitate a meeting venue and invite relevant groups and local residents to attend, to look at ways to move forward to develop a partnership project to enter the regional East Midland In Bloom 2015. It was resolved that 1 x Thursday use of main hall, The Centre (subject to availability) per month for a three month period be granted (FOC) to New Hope Community Church to pilot a Luncheon Club project.
