CHAIRMANS REPORT

06/14 The Centre – Annual Beer Festival. The Chair reported on the success of the Annual Beer Festival held at The Centre on 2nd/3rd & 4th May 2014. Each evening had live music with headlining bands performing – Natterjacks, Marv White Band & Sean Webster Band. The Chairman thanked all staff who continued to work hard to achieve the success of The Centre events. He added that a new bar frontage had been made to accommodate temporary fittings for a ‘secondary’ festival bar area. He thanked the staff responsible for the design & construction. The temporary bar area would be used for all Centre out-bar requirements at events.

07/14 The Chairman reported on a Charity cycle event which had utilized The Centre facilities to enable their event to continue. A letter of thanks had been received from Huddersfield Town FC following use of The Centre facilities in the Annual charity event Pink Link Pedal for Pounds: The Chapman Trail Bike Ride. 300 riders and a dozen support vehicles had used The Centre car park and associated areas on the bike route, and this was key in making sure the event ran smoothly. It was resolved that HTFC be offered use of The Centre facility in their annual fundraising event. (The Clerk circulated photographs of the event to Members).

- a. The application is outside the settlement framework for Clowne
- b. Requires an Environmental Impact Assessment due to local habitat of protected wildlife (i.e.: Bats, Red Kite etc.)
- c. Traffic Management Survey (due to the single track route to the proposed development)
- d. Pre-requisite of ANY development would be to upgrade roads and infrastructure.
