**COUNTY COUNCIL REPORT**

Cllr Western congratulated all Members of the Clowne Parish Council following their recent election.

It was noted that Council Surgeries will re-commence Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2015.

Cllr Western explained the financial restraints on budgets for the forthcoming period and that new initiatives were being investigated to generate additional income for the DCC. This would include the establishment of Solar farms on brown-field sites. The additional funds would support for funding for front line services.

Cllr Western reported on the devolution package which had been submitted to government for the Derby & Derbyshire Combined Authority which will enable monies to be spent more efficiently and effectively within the County.

Members congratulated DCC and other Agencies for the 'clean up' of the Clowne Linear Park. Cllr Western added this would continue monthly and she also added that DCC would continue to address the access problems and would look to remove the bridge and install a gradient to improve access for all.
