

NOTES OF THE MEETING OF THE CLOWNE PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 6TH OCTOBER 2014 IN THE MEETING ROOM, CLOWNE COMMUNITY CENTRE, VILLA PARK, CLOWNE COMENCING 6.45PM.

COUNTY COUNCIL REPORT

Cllr Western confirmed that the next local public information exhibition on behalf of Highways Agency to inform local communities of the future work to be done: The Source, 300 Meadowhall Way, Sheffield on Friday 10th and Saturday 11th October.

Derbyshire County Council will be holding a Public Consultation meeting on **Wednesday 22nd October 2014 3pm – 8pm (Drop in any time) @ The Centre, Villa Park, Clowne** .

Cllr Western asked for parishioners to share their opinions and ideas in the future of the Clowne Branch Line. The disused railway line running through the centre of Clowne has recently been purchased by Derbyshire County Council with a view to developing it as a Trail for walkers, cyclists and horse riders.

Officers of the County Council will be present to gain local knowledge on the Branch Line and learn how this facility can best be developed to serve the local community.

A further 'litter pick' has been organized by Friends of Clowne Greenway and this will take place on Saturday 11th October a.m.

Cllr Western reported that the Local Area Committee had been re-instated and would be addressing services at local levels. A meeting had been arranged for 26/11/14 to look at requirements for Clowne. The Chairman re-iterated his concerns for the proposed developments and potential growth of Clowne with a need for a Parish Plan.

POLICE

The Chairman welcomed PCSO Wardle & PCSO Levers to the meeting. The police representatives presented the monthly crime figures for September 2014.

All present at the meeting were enthusiastic and willing to work in partnership with the Parish Council. It was agreed that areas would be prioritized.

The initial area for first stage design was agreed as: Mill Green Way.
