**MINUTES – 05/01/15**

197/15 Resolved that the Minutes of the Clowne Parish Council meeting held on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2015 be approved and adopted and signed as a true record.

**ACTION FOR THE PUBLIC FORUM**

198/15 The Chairman reported on the various times of business relating to the BDC, DCC and the police which had been discussed and would be forwarded on to the relevant Departments.

199/15 Cllr Reid reported that a meeting would be held by representatives of DCC & BDC to discuss a Neighbourhood Plan: MONDAY 16<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY @ THE CENTRE commencing 7pm (DCC to facilitate).

### **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT**

200/15 CCTV: The Chair reported on a recent meeting which had taken place @ BDC The Arc, to assess the provision of CCTV in Clowne. He explained that the cameras were operational (following recent problems) – the working, monitoring & recording process still needed to be evaluated before any financial commitment from Clowne Parish Council. Cllr Reid re-iterated that the Parish Council should not pay for the system until all operational systems had been checked and that Members were completely happy with the service and the re-siting of several cameras. The CCTV re-location sites had been recommended previously by the police Safer Neighbourhood Team and Clowne Parish Council. It was recommended to await a further update.

201/15 Allotments, Hickinwood Lane, Clowne. Cllr Reid reported on a recent meeting held on 26/01/15 with tenants of Hickinwood Allotments. He explained the purpose of the meeting was to allay fears of the tenants and re-iterate the Council commitment to the administration of their tenancy agreements. Cllr Reid also explained that the Parish Council would not be responsible to manage/administer the Clowne Gardenholders Group as this was a separate issue. He added that the Gardenholders Shop would still remain open and available to Allotment Tenants.

202/15 Cllr Reid reported that an employee of the Parish Council had been involved in an accident on his way home from work. BDC CAN Rangers had witnessed the incident and were on hand to offer assistance. Members expressed their concerns. (Staffing would be re-organized to enable continued use of Centre facilities).

## PRECEPT

This sum is to be distributed in the overall administration costs of the Council. Clowne Parish Council is charged with the task of ensuring the village remain a clean and safe place. The Parish Council is committed to planning numerous community events and encourage parishioner participation and involvement.

Clowne Parish Council will look to support the upgrade, modification and relocation of new & existing CCTV in the village addressing local parishioners' fear of crime. The Council will also look at proposals for the development of an enhanced Garden of Remembrance at the site of the original War Memorial (subject to necessary planning & conservation consent).
