The Chairman reported that a meeting with public consultation would take place on Wednesday 15th July 2015 @ The Centre commencing 12noon – 6pm to discuss the Cycle Pathway / Local Greenway.

46/15 It was confirmed that the Declaration of Interest Book had been signed.

47/15 Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Cllrs A Patterson, Connerton and T Patterson.

MINUTES – 01/06/15

48/15 Resolved that the Minutes of the Clowne Parish Council meeting held on Monday 1st June 2015 be approved and adopted and signed as a true record.

ACTION FROM THE PUBLIC FORUM & CHAIRMANS REPORT

49/15 The Chairman reported on various items of business relating to the BDC, DCC and the police which had been discussed and would be forwarded to the relevant Departments.

50/15 Following on from previous discussion in Public Forum and Minute 27/15 it was agreed that an Open Public Consultation Evening would be arranged for parishioners to talk to local Members and other Agencies to look into the possibilities of the production of a Neighbourhood Development Plan for Clowne. (Date tbc – July 2015).

51/15 Cllr Reid reported on the numerous comments of appreciation and thanks received for the annual Party on the Park event staged on Villa Park area on Saturday 4th July 2015.

52/15 The Chairman (on behalf of Members of the Parish Council) thanked everyone involved in the success of the recent Party on the Park event held on Saturday 4th July 2015. All staff members had worked extremely hard throughout the day and night (event 12noon – 11pm). Cllr Reid reported that the event had been hugely successful, with many parishioners giving excellent feedback on social media and the Parish website. Numerous bands played throughout the day, giving musical background to a hot summer day. Numbers attending the event increased (2000+) and there were various activities, a fun fair, many stalls and a RAF Spitfire fly over (which received emotional applause from some parishioners).

53/15 The Chairman reported that the 3 shrubbed areas on Mill Green Way were completed. Wooden sleepers had been installed and erected to create the 3 areas. The areas had then been cultivated, plants provided and planted by Clowne Parish Council. Clowne in Bloom had supported the initiative and would continue to work in partnership with the Parish Council for the 3 x bedded areas to become areas of focus for the village. (BDC agreed to license Clowne PC to cultivate the area).

CORRESPONDENCE / ITEMS TO THE COUNCIL

54/15 Correspondence had been received from a parishioner re: Clowne Cemetery, Barlborough Road, Clowne (see Minute 29/15). Resolved that this item of business was to be dealt with by Clowne & Barlborough Joint Burial Committee and all correspondence would be forwarded to the Clerk.

55/15 Read & Noted. Letter from local resident regarding the lack of play provision in Clowne .

56/15. Read & Noted. A letter had been received from a parishioner re: parking problems on Neale Street, Clowne. Resolved that correspondence be forwarded to Cllr Western DCC and DCC Highways Dept for action.

57/15 Read & Noted. A letter had been received from a parishioner regarding the Footpath through Spring Vale from Harlethorpe Lane & Creswell Road, Clowne. It was resolved that correspondence be forwarded to Cllr Western DCC and Right of Way Dept, DCC for action.

58/15 Read & Noted. Information from ANESCO Ltd re: proposed Oxcroft Solar PV Project @ Stanfree, Chesterfield S44 6AG (location : ex-Oxcroft Screening Plant).

59/15 Read & Noted. Information BLSP Parish Liaison re: cancellation of meeting to be held on 6/7/15 and re-scheduled meeting for 21st September @ 1.30pm (information to be circulated at later date).

60/15 A request had been received from a parishioner re: request for use of The Centre to hold a Fundraising event on Saturday 1st August for MacMillan Cancer Support. It was resolved that use of The Centre (FOC) be approved (subject to availability).

61/15 Correspondence had been received from a parishioner re: Proposal for Local Pan. It was noted that a Public Consultation Day would be arranged for parishioners to comment on ideas/proposals for the area development.

62/15 The Chairman reported on the WW1 Centenary Arts Commission initiative and explained that an Information for Expression of Interest had been submitted for 'The Poppies Wave & Weeping Window' . Members discussed proposals for a service/dedication for the Garden of Remembrance on completion of the works late August/September. It was agreed that the Parish Council would facilitate a commemorative service involving local organizations and interested parties.

63/15 Read & Noted. Information from Land Registry: application for acquiring of land @ Rectory Road, Clowne. It was noted that this area had been maintained as a residential garden.

64/15 Noted. Information from DALC – General information Circulars 15, 16 & 17

65/15 The Chairman reported on a recent meeting with Clowne In Bloom and East Midland in Bloom to look at entry to future regional village competition.

66/15 Read & Noted. Information from BDC and a request to meet Parish Council from newly appointed Senior Economic Development Officer. It was suggested that a meeting be arranged following the next Parish Council meeting.

PLANNING

Cllr Smith declared an interest and took no part in the discussion and left the room.

67/15 APPLICATION No: 15/00238/FUL Retention of fence @ 2 Thoresby Avenue, Clowne for Mr D.Austick Members expressed the following concerns:- the retention of the fence was visually unattractive as per the 'street scene' for the neighbourhood.

68/15 APPLICATION 15/00257/FUL Erection of a single storey dwelling @ 57 Ringer Lane, Clowne for Mr Kitchen. Members expressed their concerns regarding increased volume of traffic and traffic movement, poor vehicular access and visibility and recommend adequate off road car parking provision.

69/15 APPLICATION 15/00234/FUL Single storey front, side and rear extensions, linking the dwelling and the existing garage that would be converted to form additional accommodation @ 29 Southwood Drive, Clowne for Mr & Mrs Hannan. Subject to adequate off road car parking provision.

70/15 APPLICATION 15/00078/FUL Removal of existing new shop front @ 11 Mill Street, Clowne for Mr I Huttinson. Members expressed their concerns and recommended that the development follow the guidelines and restraints appropriate as it is within the Conservation Area.

71/15 APPLICATION 15/000280/LAWEX Certificate of lawful existing use for vehicle repair, storage, recovery & sales @ Unit 2, Forest Buildings, 41 Creswell Road, Clowne for Mr D Johnson. NO COMMENTS.

72/15 APPLICATION 15/000266/FUL Vehicular access and formation of a hardstanding (retrospective) @ 111 Boughton Lane, Clowne for Mr Essex. NO COMMENTS.

73/15 APPLICATION 15/00293/FUL Erection of two storey dwelling to rear @ 45 Mitchell Street, Clowne for Mrs C Henshaw. Members continued to expressed concerns for the increasing 'backland planning' developments. This would increase volume and movement of traffic on a congested street.

74/15 APPLICATION 15/00289/FUL Single storey extension to side @ 20 Bentinck Drive, Clowne for Mr Hall. Members recommend adequate off road car parking provision.
