The Chairman asked for parishioners to remain vigilant with their vehicle safety following an increase in vehicle theft in the area.

COUNTY COUNCIL REPORT

The Chairman welcomed Cllr Western to the meeting.

Cllr Western reported on the recent Open Day for the Greenway. She added that regular litter picking and minor maintenance are being undertaken by Groundwork and volunteers along the Linear Park area.

Cllr Western gave a detailed report on the recent Devolution deal @ government level to enable Derbyshire & Nottinghamshire to acquire more local level funding opportunities. The bid had been submitted on 04/09/15 and this was to address:

- Transport
- Economic development
- Infra structure
- Education
- Social care

Cllr Western answered numerous parishioners' questions on various issues relating to Clowne.

Cllr Western was keen to liaise with the District Council on the reports of lorries not adhering to planning conditions regarding the use of appropriate wheel wash for lorries entering and exiting the development site on Mansfield Road, Clowne. This follows numerous complaints by parishioners regarding the poor state of the highway. It was agreed that DCC, BDC & CPC contact the Developers regarding action to be taken to alleviate the problem on Mansfield Road, Clowne.

DECLARATION OF INTEREST

84/15 It was confirmed that the Declaration of Interest Book had been signed.

APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

85/15 Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Cllrs A Patterson and Buxton.

MINUTES – 06/07/15

86/15 Resolved that the Minutes of the Clowne Parish Council held on Monday 6th July 2015 be approved and adopted and signed as a true record.

ACTION FROM THE PUBLIC FORUM / CHAIRMANS REPORT

87/15 The Chairman reported on various items of business relating to BDC, DCC and the police which had been discussed and would be forwarded onto the relevant Departments.

88/15 Digital Derbyshire. The Chairman reported on a recent meeting with Kerry Bailey, Digital Derbyshire Engagement Officer, to raise the awareness of broadband services available across Derbyshire. He explained that DCC is working in partnership with BT to lay hundreds of miles of fibre optic cable, bringing better, faster broadband to parts of Derbyshire including areas of Clowne. Cllr Reid added that a Launch Event was to take place on Friday 11th September 2015 @ Ashlea Green, Clowne 5pm-7pm (and at the Clowne Gala on Saturday 12th September 11am-3pm) to give residents of Clowne an insight into the availability of digital broadband.

89/15 Clowne Gala The Chairman reported on the forthcoming Clowne Gala on Saturday 12th September 2015 11am – 3pm to be held at Heritage High School with many stalls and attractions.

90/15 Party on the Park 2015 The Chairman was pleased to announce that over £2000 had been raised for Help for Heroes charity. Members expressed their appreciation to staff of the Parish Council and the local community for their support in raising funds and requested that the Regional Office be contacted and arrange presentation of the funds.

91/15 Garden of Remembrance Cllr Reid explained that the development of the new Garden of Remembrance had fallen behind schedule due to unforeseen problems including the recent adverse weather conditions. Cllr Reid gave a brief update on works on the site. He added that the artwork and all groundworks would be completed for October and the surrounding fencing would be installed mid November. To ensure the safety of the sculpture and artworks the Herring fencing would remain in situ and removed prior to the Remembrance Service on Sunday November 9th. Arrangements are underway with the Diocese of Derby to seek the dedication of the site prior to Remembrance Day – the date yet to be determined.

92/15 CT4TC – Announcement of two organizations to join forces – Clowne Community Transport & Community Transport for Town & County (information circulated). Members asked the CPC representative for CDCT Committee Member address the issue of possible hospital bus service availability in the future.

Due to prior commitments of the Consultants the meeting had been scheduled and re-scheduled on several dates with a mutually convenient date as WEDNESDAY 9TH SEPTEMBER 15. The presentations would be given to the Council on how they would envisage developing a Local Plan for Clowne.

101/15 A Member asked for consideration to the installation of a seat on the Garden of Remembrance. The Chair explained that the approved design of the development had incorporated seating within the castellation design work. The Member felt this was not adequate and would look to present a Motion for Debate to Council at the next meeting of the Parish Council (Monday 5th October 15).
